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Nordstrom Rack To Open At City Center In White Plains, New York

SEATTLE (April 22, 2008)—Seattle-based Nordstrom, Inc. (NYSE: JWN), a leading fashion specialty retailer, announced today that it will open a 35,000 square-foot Nordstrom Rack at City Center Shopping Center in White Plains, NY in fall 2008.

Nordstrom Rack is the company's off-price retail division offering savings of 30 to 75 percent on apparel and accessories for women, men and children, including one of the most extensive collections of name-brand shoes available. Nordstrom Rack merchandise is made up of products from Nordstrom full-line stores and the company's online store at Nordstrom.com, as well as special purchase items.

"City Center is a compelling destination with a great mix of retail, restaurants and entertainment, and we're excited to be a part of it," said Scott Meden, president of Nordstrom Rack. "We're eager to open our doors and we hope that this new store will make shopping more convenient for customers in and around White Plains."

The Nordstrom Rack at City Center will be the retailer's second Rack store in New York. Nordstrom also operates a Rack at The Mall at the Source in Hempstead. In addition to its Rack stores, Nordstrom also operates two full-line stores in New York at Roosevelt Field in Garden City and The Westchester in White Plains.

"We are extremely pleased to have Nordstrom Rack become a key component in City Center's retail community," said Louis R. Cappelli, president of Cappelli Enterprises, the developer and owner of the complex. "Nordstrom is a prestigious name in the world of fashion retailing. The Rack fits perfectly within our mix of tenants that includes very strong fashion retailers such as Filene's Basement, as well as numerous other top-end retailers such as Target and Barnes & Noble. City Center plays an important role in the overall retail success of Downtown White Plains. Having Nordstrom Rack join our tenant roster brings even greater strength to our center and the city as a whole."

White Plains Mayor Joseph Delfino said that the addition of Nordstrom Rack to the retail community in the heart of the city is the latest testimony to the continuing vibrancy of the city's downtown. "Our city was proud when Nordstrom opened its first store in New

York State here at The Westchester in 1995. Now we are pleased that White Plains will be offering another aspect of the Nordstrom shopping experience at City Center.”

City Center is a \$350 million residential-retail-entertainment complex in the heart of downtown White Plains. The 1.1 million square-foot development opened in October 2003. The complex features 400,000 square-feet of retail, which includes Barnes & Noble, Circuit City, Filene’s Basement, Target and New York Sports Club. It also has 30,000 square-feet of restaurants, a 15-screen national Amusements Multiplex, the 450-seat White Plains Performing Arts Center and a residential component called One City Place.
